



Guest Policy 2011

The pool is available to all members and their immediate families at no charge. In-town guests are limited to 6 visits per season and will be charged \$5.00 per visit. Out-of-town guests will be charged \$2.50 per visit. In-town family members who are not considered immediate family will be considered in-town guests. **The Board of Directors defines immediate family as: spouse, children, and parents who reside in the members' home on a permanent basis.** Members may bring a guest on Tuesdays free of charge.

Pool Parties

Private pool parties may be arranged through the Food and Beverage Department or General Manager. All parties must be booked and chaperoned by at least one adult of the group. Guests may be included in private parties and are the responsibility of the host. There is a \$5.00 minimum per person charge for pool parties, for all attendees, **including members**. A second lifeguard will be needed for all parties with more than 10 people for safety reasons. The charge per lifeguard is \$25.00 per hour with a minimum of 2 hours. Private Parties may be booked thru the food and beverage department and allowed during the following pool hours. All food and services must be handled by HCC staff and priced according to needs and number of guest. Our goal is to have fun parties and not take away from our normal member usage. Times allowed, any day between 2:00 PM and 4:00 PM, along with any evening after 6:00 PM. All Private parties must end by 10:00 PM to follow the City of Henderson Noise ordinances. The relationship with our neighbors is important to all of us.

Swimming Lessons

Swimming lessons can be arranged by contacting the Pool Manager or lifeguards. Group or individual lessons may be available. You are responsible for ensuring your child's attendance.

Grandchildren Policy

All non-resident grandchildren under the age of 21 are always welcome at the HCC pool and may be charged a guest fee as established by HCC by laws. Any sitters including parents may be treated as a guest and will need to follow guest policies.

Babysitter Policy

Non-member babysitters will be allowed to attend the pool while they are representing the member's family. No guest fee will apply, but all food and beverage service must be charged to members account. The babysitter must follow all pool rules and must supervise the child/children at all times while in the pool area. Babysitters are not allowed to bring guests.

Pool Breaks

All swimmers under the age of 18 are required to take a 10 minute pool break every hour at 10 minutes until the hour. Swimmers under the age of 18 must remain completely out of the water (entire body including hands, arms, and legs). The shallow end of the pool is also off limits. Only children under the age of 2 are allowed in the pool with an adult of age 18 or older during breaks.

Pool Hours

Our Pool is a Great asset to our club and we plan to be open to fit our members' needs. The pool will officially open Memorial Day Weekend with a Pool Kickoff Party Friday May 27, 2011. Check out your newsletter for this event. The pool will close Labor Day September 5, 2011 at 6:00 PM. Check out your newsletter for our End of Summer Bash 2011. We will staff lifeguards weekends till our lifeguards come home or are out of school full time. All pool hours will be posted in the newsletter.
