



# HCC Pool Rules for 2011

We want a SAFE FUN Family Place for our members!

## **General:**

1. All members and guests must sign in daily.
2. All persons should shower before entering the pool.
3. Swim at your own risk after hours. You must be 18 years or older or accompanied by a family club member.
4. Pool will be completely cleared during storms. Swimming will resume at discretion of the pool manager or lifeguards.

## **Food & Beverages:**

5. All food and beverages are to be purchased at the club.
6. Abuse of Alcoholic Beverages or Staff will not be tolerated.
7. Food and drinks are to be consumed only in the snack bar or at the tables on the pool deck.
8. No glass containers allowed in the pool area.

## **Attire:**

9. Proper swim attire is required in the pool.
10. Babies in diapers must wear rubber diaper covers. Swimmies are allowed with a rubber diaper cover.
11. When entering the snack bar, proper attire is required (shoes, shirt/cover-up).

## **Health:**

12. Advise lifeguards in advance of health problems.
13. Anyone with an open wound, skin infection, or communicable disease will be excluded from the pool.
14. No dogs or pets allowed in the pool area.
15. No smoking in the pool area.
16. No chewing gum in the pool area.

## **Safety:**

17. Balls and flotation devices may be used at the discretion of the pool manager or lifeguards. No flotation devices allowed in the deep end.
18. Children wearing swim wings must have an adult present with them in the pool, except in the shallow end.
19. No running or pushing on the pool deck.
20. No standing or playing near the lifeguard stand.
21. No dunking, horseplay, or sitting on shoulders.
22. No diving in shallow water (observe "No Diving" signs).
23. Only one person on the diving board at a time.
24. Children under 10 years of age must be chaperoned by someone of at least 15 years of age.
25. Only pool toys allowed in the pool.
- 26. Please notify pool manager or pool staff of any problems or concerns immediately.**

**27. All persons using the pool and pool area must do so at their own risk. The club is not responsible for any accident or injury in connection with such use. Please report all accidents or injuries to a lifeguard or the pool manager.**
